Supplies Needed

1 sheet of 8-1/2" x 11" cardstock Scoring Tool or scoring blade on the paper trimmer Scissors Tear Tape or Liquid Glue Corner rounder punch 2" Circle punch



Directions

- 1. Score the cardstock along the long (11") edge at 2-3/4", 3-1/4", 7-3/4", 8-1/4"
- 2. Score the cardstock along the short (8-1/2") edge at 1", 1-1/2", 7-1/2", 8"
- 3. Fold and crease all score lines in the same direction towards the center of the cardstock.
- 4. Cut away all four corners as shown by the shaded portions of the diagram.
- 5. Use a corner rounder to round the corners of the top flap of the box.
- 6. Use Tear Tape or Liquid Glue to adhere the box together. One piece of Tear Tape goes at the bottom and the other goes on the edge of one of the side flaps.
- 7. Hold the bottom flap of the box secure while folding over one side flap, then fold over the other side flap and secure.
- 8. Use a circle punch to cut a half circle along the top of the box where the flap will be inserted to make it easier to take the cards in and out of the box.
