## Card Template - Paper Scraps & Faux Quilting



Create a lovely faux quilt top with 1" strips of patterned paper.

## **Supplies Needed**

- 5.5" x 8.5" Cardstock base
- 5.25" x 4" Cardstock quarter
- 1" x 6" strips of double-sided patterned paper (2)
- 1" x 4" strips of double-sided patterned paper (6-8)
- Scraps to create sentiment shape for the card front
- Embossing Folders with small patterns
- Stitched dies for sentiment
- Cut & Emboss Machine
- Tombow Multipurpose Liquid Glue



## **Directions**

- 1. On the quarter sheet of cardstock measuring 5.25" x 4", adhere one of the 1" x 6" strips of DSP diagonally across the center. Adhere the second 1" x 6" piece along side the first leaving a small gap in between. The ends of the strips should hang off the side of the cardstock quarter until all the strips are adhered.
- 2. Now adhere one of the 1" x 4" strips perpendicular to the strip adhered first in step 1 and overlapping the corner.
- 3. Adhere another 1"x 4" strip perpendicularly on the opposite side offset from the strip in step 2.
- 4. Continue adhering strips perpendicular to each other to fill in the remaining space on the cardstock quarter.
- 5. Let the glue dry. Turn the cardstock quarter to the back and trim off the overhanging edges with scissors. Now comes the fun part!!!!!
- 6. Choose your favorite embossing folder and emboss the entire cardstock quarter. This will create the quilted fabric look.
- 7. Mount this piece onto a card base.
- 8. Stamp a sentiment onto a stitched focal point and add some ribbon to embellish.
