## Stampin' Card Template - #6 Perpendicular Perfection

These papers are aligned perpendicularly to create a pleasing effect.

## **Supplies Needed**

- 5-1/2" x 8-1/2" cardstock base, scored at 4-1/4""
- 4" x 5-1/4" patterned paper #1
- 1-3/4" x 4-1/2" patterned paper #2
- 2-1/4" x 3-1/4" cardstock or patterned paper #3
- 3/4" x 2-1/2" Basic White or patterned paper
- 4" ribbon



## **Directions**

- 1. This template is designed to work on a horizontal card. Attach the  $4" \times 5-1/4"$  patterned paper #1 to the card base.
- 2. Attach the 1-3/4" x 4-1/2" piece of patterned paper #2 on the front of the card base over the first piece of patterned paper, centering it vertically and horizontally.
- 3. If desired, stamp on or decorate the 2-1/4" x 3-1/4" piece of patterned paper/cardstock. This piece is main decorative focal point of the card front.
- 4. Attach the 2-1/4" x 3-1/4" patterned paper #3 or cardstock vertically (perpendicularly) over the second piece of patterned paper. The top and bottom of this piece should be spaced equally from the edges of the card front. Place it towards the left (or right) side of the card front leaving 1/4" of the 1-3/4" x 4-1/2" piece showing on the left.
- 5. Stamp a greeting sentiment on the piece of 3/4" x 2-1/2" Basic White or patterned paper. Attach this piece towards the right side of the card front along the bottom edge of the 1-3/4" x 4-1/2" patterned paper #2, AND overlapping focal point piece around 3/4". This piece should be popped up with dimensionals.
- 6. Tie ribbon in a knot and attach at a point where all the pieces intersect.

## **Ways to Step-Up the Template**

- $\bullet$  Use an embossing folder on the 2-1/4" x 3-1/4" cardstock or patterned paper #3
- Add extra layers of cardstock to matte the patterned paper.
  - 2-1/2" x 3-1/2" for matting patterned paper #3
  - 1" x 2-3/4" for the sentiment piece.
- Add a layer of coordinating ribbon under the sentiment piece
- Use a rectangular shaped punch or die to create the sentiment piece
