

Stampin' Template - Rip & Flip Card

Use this pattern to create fast card fronts utilizing both sides of Designer Series Paper.



Supplies Needed

- 3" x 4" Designer Series Paper
- 3 1/4" x 4 1/4" coordinating cardstock
- 5 1/2" x 8 1/2" for card base in second coordinating cardstock color
- Punches for focal point

Directions

1. Tear DSP at about 1" from long edge. To tear, "pinch" DSP with both hands and tear up towards yourself. This will create the beautiful white torn edge.
2. Take the torn off strip and flip it to the opposite side and layer just under the tear line. Adhere pieces to the coordinating cardstock layering piece.
3. Stamp a background image onto the card base if desired and adhere the layering piece on top.
4. Stamp focal point image and pop up onto the torn edge of the layering piece.

Rip & Flip Variation

4" x 5 1/4" DSP on top of card base
