Stampin' Template - Rip & Flip Card



Use this pattern to create fast card fronts utilizing both sides of Designer Series Paper.



Supplies Needed

- 3" x 4" Designer Series Paper
- 3 1/4" x 4 1/4" coordinating cardstock
- 5 1/2" x 8 1/2" for card base in second coordinating cardstock color
- Punches for focal point

Directions

- 1. Tear DSP at about 1" from long edge. To tear, "pinch" DSP with both hands and tear up towards yourself. This will create the beautiful white torn edge.
- 2. Take the torn off strip and flip it to the opposite side and layer just under the tear line. Adhere pieces to the coordinating cardstock layering piece.
- 3. Stamp a background image onto the card base if desired and adhere the layering piece on top.
- 4. Stamp focal point image and pop up onto the torn edge of the layering piece.

Rip & Flip Variation

4" x 5 1/4" DSP on top of card base
