

Stampin' 3D Pattern - May Day Basket

Use this pattern to create adorable baskets in 2 sizes!

Supplies Needed for Large Basket

- 8.5" x 8.5" Double-sided Pattern Paper or Cardstock
- 1" x 8.5" coordinating cardstock strip for handle
- Additional coordinating cardstock for decorating basket
- Seal+ Adhesive or strong adhesive



Directions for Large Basket

1. Decide which side of the patterned paper is going to be the outside and which is going to be the inside OR stamp a background on one side of the cardstock.
2. Score 2.5" from each side of the DSP/Cardstock square. (See picture)
3. Fold and crease on all the score lines in the direction of the inside of the basket.
4. Choose one side of the square and cut on the score lines as shown in the picture to create corner flaps. Do the same thing on the opposite side.
5. Cut each flap into 3 equal strips by making 2 cuts with your scissors (eyeballing it is just fine). These cuts will be parallel to the cut that created the flap in the first place.
6. On the sides of the basket that are in between the flaps (as shown), fold about 0.5" towards the inside of the basket and adhere.
7. Apply Seal+ Adhesive on the ends of all the little flaps on the side that is the inside of the basket.
8. Starting with the flaps closest to the side of the basket, bring them together across the side of the basket, overlapping the ends and adhering to the side. These two flaps will be angled slightly up. Then bring the next 2 flaps together across the first two and attach. Finally, bring the last 2 flaps together and attach over the others. These two will be angled slightly down.
9. Give the 1" x 8.5" cardstock strip a slight curve by gently curling it with a bone folder. Then attach it to the basket on the inside to create a handle.
10. Boom! You did it!

Dimensions for Mini Tote Bag

- 6" x 6" Double-sided Pattern Paper or Cardstock
- 1.5" x 6" coordinating cardstock strip for handle

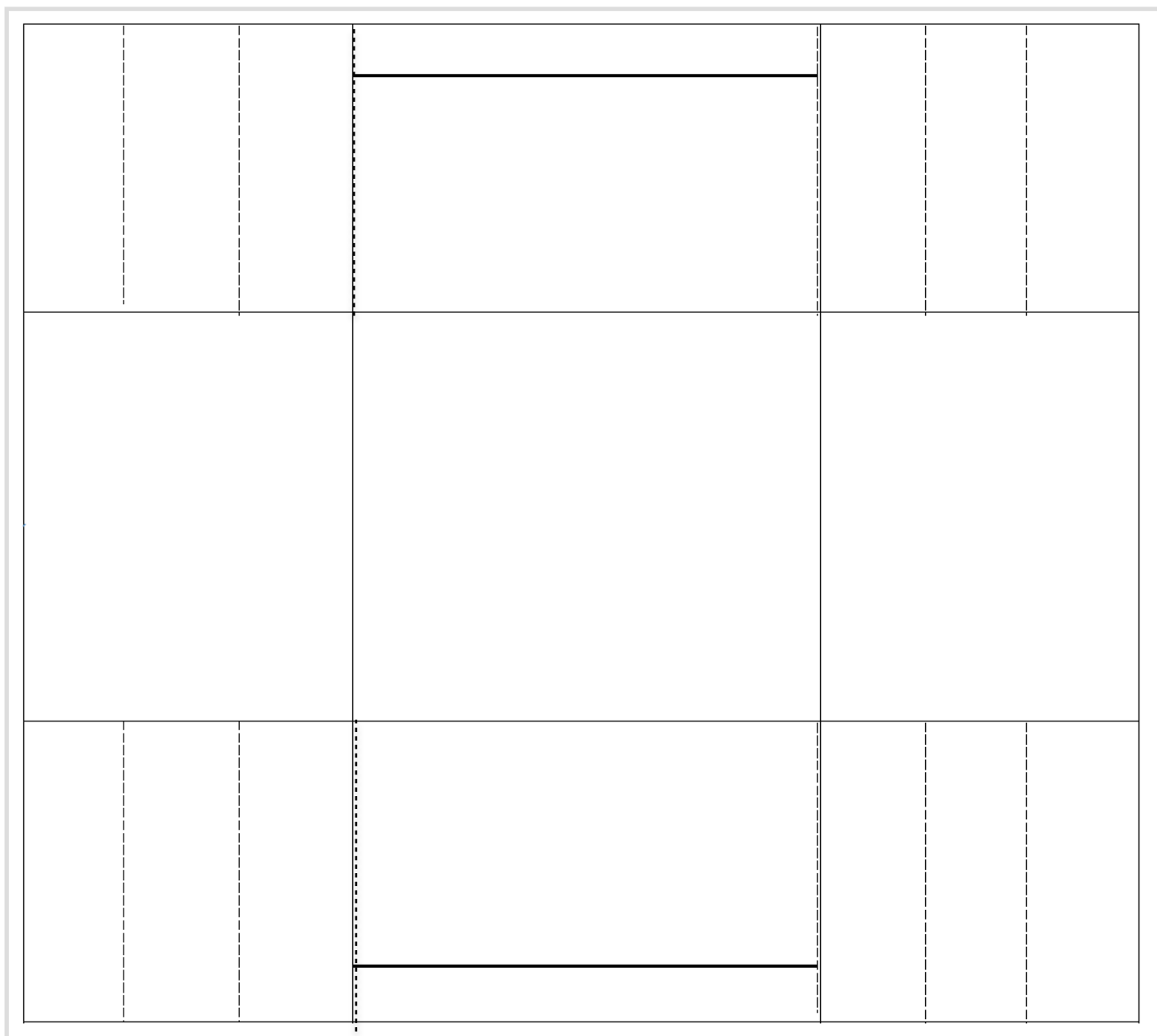
Directions for Mini Tote Bag (exactly the same except for the following)

1. Score 1.75" from each side of the DSP/Cardstock square.
2. Fold the 2 sides that are in between the flaps over about 0.25" towards the inside of the basket.

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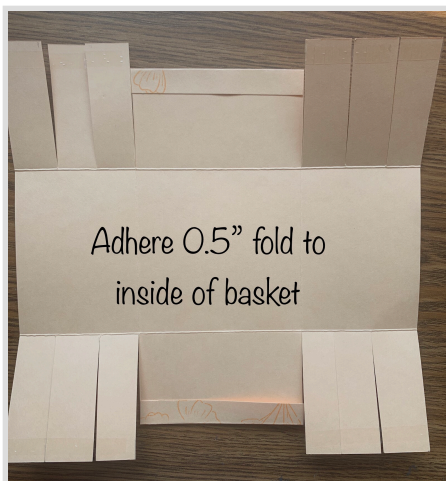
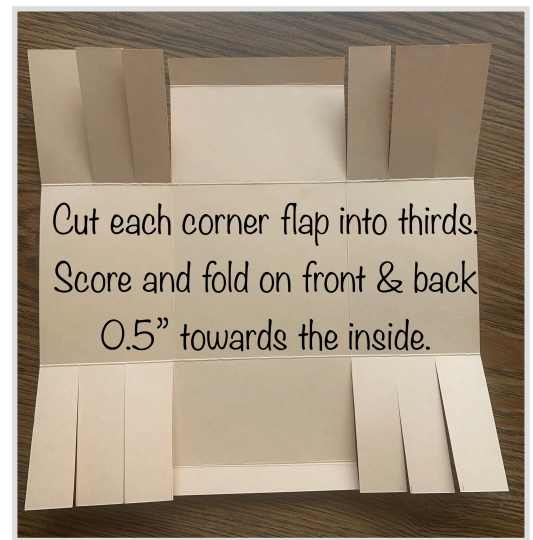
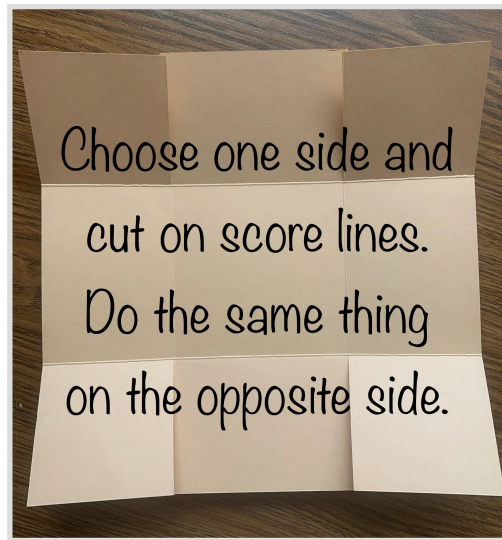
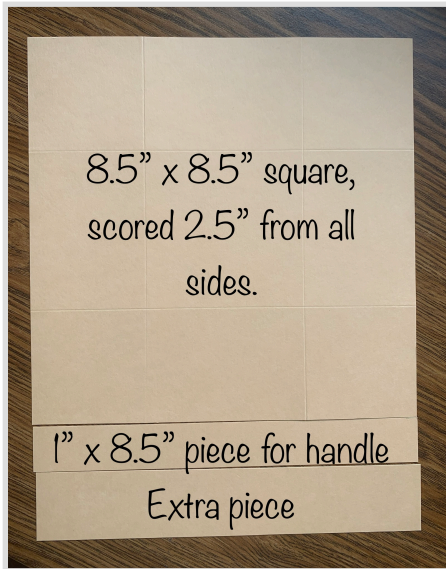


Dotted line = Cutting
