

# Stampin' Pattern - 6 Fast Cards & Card Holder



Great for gift giving - a set of cards and a holder to gift them!

## Supplies:

- 1 sheet 12 x 12 patterned paper
- 1 sheet 8.5" x 11" cardstock for holder
- 1 sheet 8.5" x 11" cardstock for accent pieces
- 3 sheets 8.5" x 11" cardstock for card bases
- Punches or dies for greeting images and cardstock scraps
- Banner Pick a Punch for decorative ends
- 24 " ribbon
- Embellishments as needed

\*How to cut the 12 x 12 patterned paper:

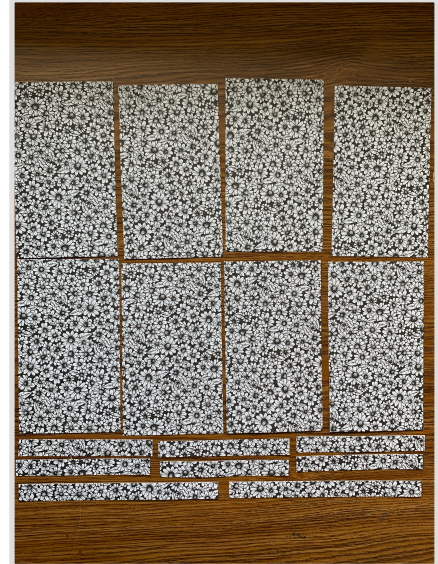
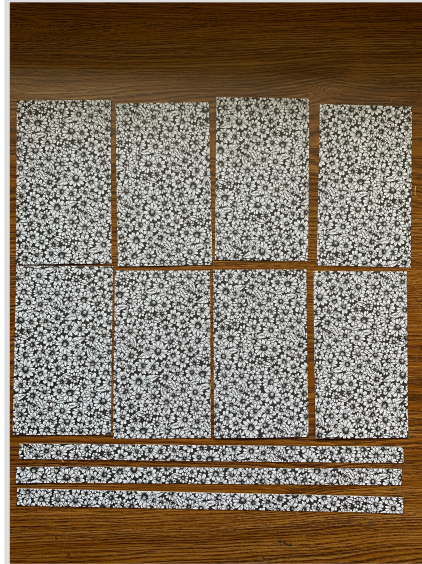
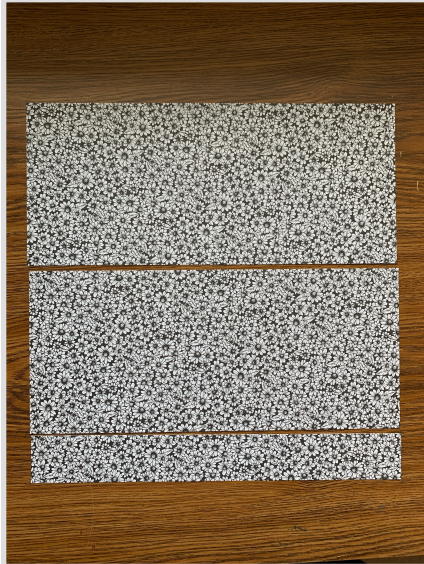
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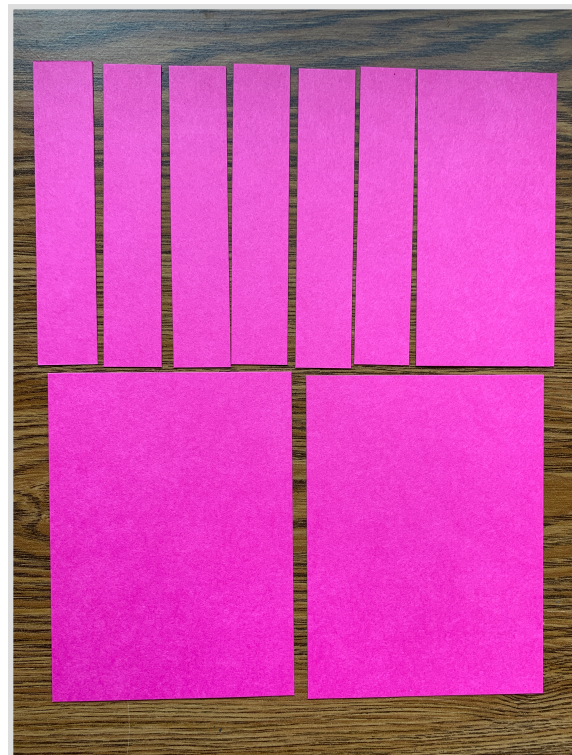
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## Directions for Cutting the 12 x 12 paper:

1. Determine if your patterned paper has directionality or not - this will affect how you make the first cut.  
Cut two strips that measure  $5\frac{1}{4}" \times 12"$ , and three strips that are  $1\frac{1}{2}" \times 12"$ . Essentially you cut your piece along one edge at  $5\frac{1}{4}"$ ,  $10\frac{1}{2}"$ ,  $11"$ , and  $11\frac{1}{2}"$  to get these pieces.
2. Take the two  $5\frac{1}{2}" \times 12"$  pieces and cut them into 3" pieces to get 8 pieces measuring  $3" \times 5\frac{1}{4}"$ .
3. Take two of the  $1\frac{1}{2}" \times 12"$  and cut them into 4" pieces to get 6 pieces measuring  $1\frac{1}{2}" \times 4"$ .
4. Cut the remaining  $1\frac{1}{2}" \times 12"$  piece in half to get 2 pieces measuring  $1\frac{1}{2}" \times 6"$ .

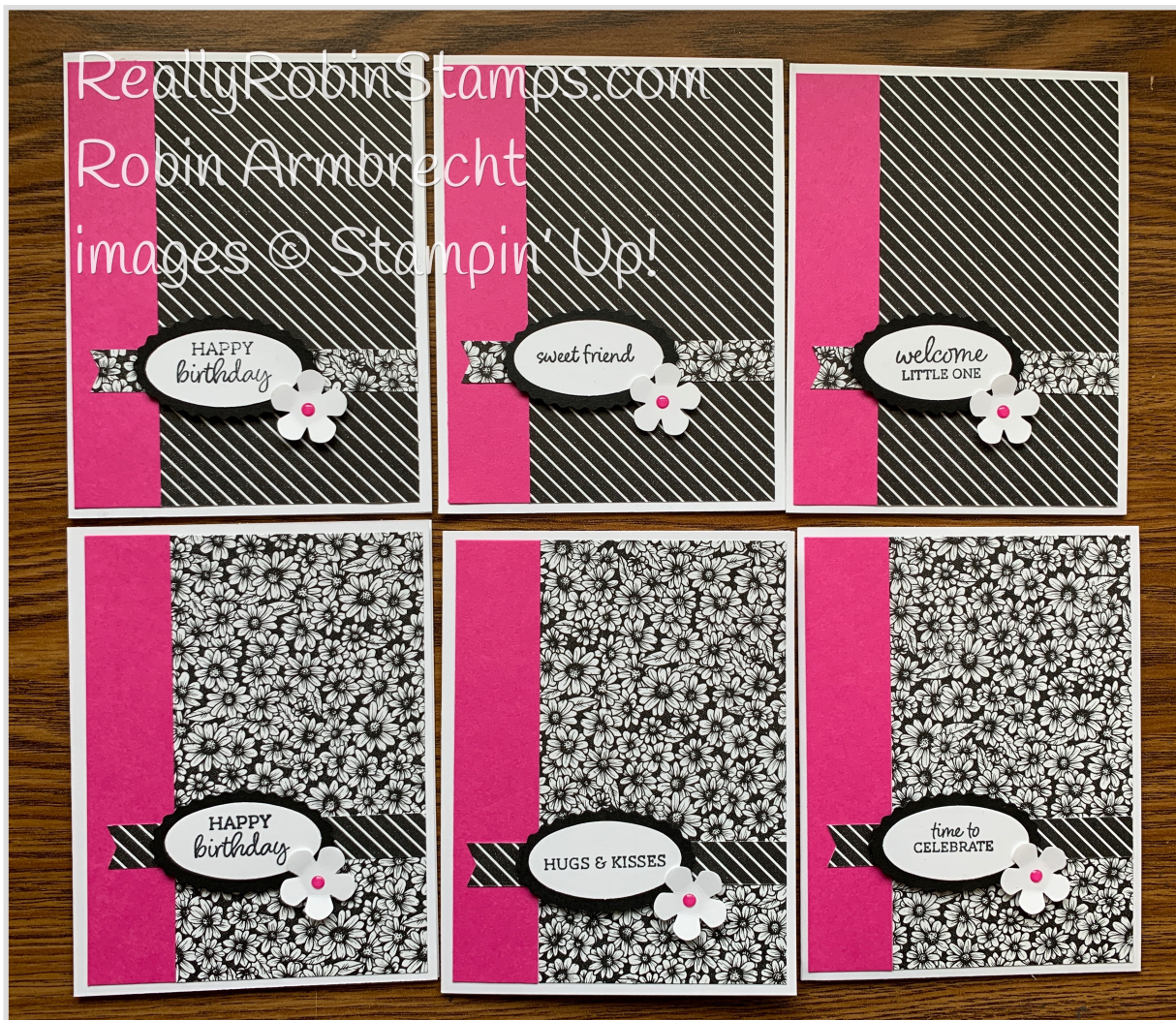
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## Directions for Assembling Cards

1. Cut 3 sheets of cardstock in half to make card bases.
2. Attach the 3" x 5 1/4" piece of patterned paper on card front along the right-hand side.
3. Attach the 1" x 5 1/4" piece of accent cardstock on the card front along the left-hand side up against the patterned paper.
4. Use a banner end punch to trim one end of the 1/2 x 4" strips of patterned paper. Attach to the card front horizontally aligning the straight end with the edge of the patterned paper so that the punched end overlaps the accent cardstock. Keep in mind the "rule of thirds" when adhering to the card front - place this strip 1/3 of the way from the top or the bottom of the card front.
5. Stamp greetings and punch out or use layering dies. Pop up with dimensionals and adhere to card front at the spot where the three pieces intersect.
6. Add a decorative accent/embellishment.





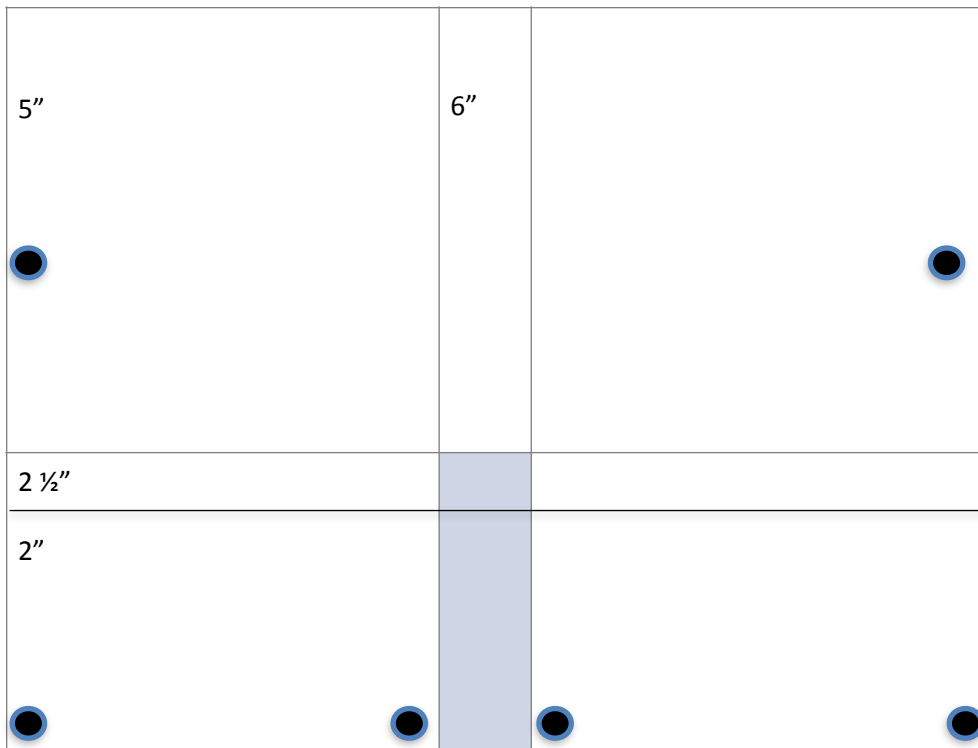
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## Directions for Assembling Card Holder

1. Score at 5" and 6" along the long edge. This creates a spine for the card holder.
2. Turn cardstock and score at 2" and 2 1/4" along the short edge. This creates the pocket to hold the cards.
3. Cut out the center spine part of the pocket section. (Shaded section on pattern)
4. Punch holes for the ribbon as shown.
5. Adhere the 4 1/4" x 5 3/4" accent cardstock pieces on the front and back, then layer the last 2 3" x 5 1/4" patterned paper on top.
6. Attach the 1/2" x 6" pieces on the spine - one on the outside and one on the inside.
7. Feed ribbon through the holes starting on the outside of the holder, in and out of the inside and through to the outside again.





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
