For when you want to create lots of cards at one time!

Supplies Needed - 8 of each piece

- 5-1/2" x 8-1/2" card bases
- 3" x 3-1/2" patterned paper
- 3" x 2" patterned paper (flip side)
- 3/4" x 4-1/4" Basic White cardstock
- Scraps for die cutting/punching embellishment



This template is designed to work on a vertical (portrait) card. You can make 8 cards at one time if using a full sheet of 12×12 double-sided patterned paper

Directions

- 1. See instructions for cutting the 12 x 12 piece of patterned paper below.
- 2. If stamping images on the card base front do that first.
- 3. Attach the 2 pieces of patterned paper along the left side of the card base front leaving about 1/8" of the card front showing next to the fold. Attach the 3" x 3-1/2" piece aligned with the top of the card and the 3" x 2" piece aligned with the bottom. They will meet. These 2 pieces of patterned paper should be different and coordinate patterns.
- 4. Stamp a long & skinny sentiment image on the 3/4" x 4-1/4" piece of Basic White cardstock. Depending on how long the image is, stamp it more on the left side so that it will be mostly centered over the patterned paper. Attach this piece to the card base, centering it directly over the seam where the 2 patterned papers meet.
- 5. Attach a punched or die cut coordinating embellishment (or ribbon) along the sentiment strip where it extends past the patterned paper, overlapping these pieces.
- 6. Add some sparkle embellishments.

Additional Ways to Vary the Template

- 1" x 5-1/2" coordinating cardstock to layer under one side of patterned papers
- 3-1/4" x 5-1/2" coordinating cardstock to matte patterned papers
- 7/8" x 4-1/4" coordinating cardstock to matte greeting strip
- Use an embossing folder on the patterned paper

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Note: The 1" x 12" strip that you cut off first will be cut in half to make 2 6" strips and can be used on the Card Holder pattern as an accent.

How to cut the 12 x 12 piece of pattern paper

- 1. Orient yourself to the pattern design and if there is a direction to the pattern make it vertical.
- 2. Cut off 1" from the bottom edge.
- 3. Cut the remaining $12" \times 11"$ piece into 3" strips. There will be 4 strips.
- 4. Stack the 4 strips on top of each other, turn horizontal and measure/cut at 3.5" two times, then measure/cut at 2".
- 5. Flip the 2" x 3" pieces to the backside pattern and pair up with the 3-1/2" x 3" pieces. ReallyRobinStamps.com
