



# Inspiration Sheet - The 2-4-6-8 Box

Create a quick and easy box for treats and small gifts!

## Supplies

- 8.5" x 5-1/2" cardstock
- 16" ribbon
- 1/8" hole punch
- Optional: 1-3/4" x 3-1/4" DSP (2)

## Directions

1. Score at 2", 4", 6" and 8" along the 8-1/2" edge.
2. Turn and score at 2" along the 5-1/2" edge.
3. Crease on all score lines in the same direction.
4. With scissors, cut on the 2" score lines up to the perpendicular score line. This will create the flaps for the bottom of the box. Cut off the small 1/2" x 2" flap on the end and discard.
5. If stamping on the box, do that now before assembling.
6. Use strong adhesive on the small 1/2" flap and attach to the opposite side to create the box.
7. Fold in all four bottom flaps and adhere the last one in place with adhesive.
8. With the front of the box facing you, pinch the sides together and bring the front and back edge of the box opening together. Punch a hole in the middle of the top edges.
9. Insert the ribbon into the hole and tie a bow to close the top of the box
10. Decorate the front of the box as desired.
11. Optional: attach the 1-3/4" x 3-1/4" patterned paper to the front and back of the box before adhering box together.
