Inspiration Sheet - The 2-4-6-8 Box

Create a quick and easy box for treats and small gifts!

Supplies

- 8.5" x 5-1/2" cardstock
- 16" ribbon
- 1/8" hole punch
- Optional: 1-3/4" x 3-1/4" DSP (2)

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Directions

- 1. Score at 2", 4", 6" and 8" along the 8-1/2" edge.
- 2. Turn and score at 2" along the 5-1/2" edge.
- 3. Crease on all score lines in the same direction.
- 4. With scissors, cut on the 2" score lines up to the perpendicular score line. This will create the flaps for the bottom of the box. Cut off the small 1/2" x 2" flap on the end and discard.
- 5. If stamping on the box, do that now before assembling.
- 6. Use strong adhesive on the small 1/2" flap and attach to the opposite side to create the box.
- 7. Fold in all four bottom flaps and adhere the last one in place with adhesive.
- 8. With the front of the box facing you, pinch the sides together and bring the front and back edge of the box opening together. Punch a hole in the middle of the top edges.
- 9. Insert the ribbon into the hole and tie a bow to close the top of the box
- 10. Decorate the front of the box as desired.
- 11. Optional: attach the 1-3/4" x 3-1/4" patterned paper to the front and back of the box before adhering box together.
