This card kit makes seven cards with different easy to replicate designs. Supplies needed in addition to the Card Kit

- Adhesives (Liquid Glue or Seal, Dimensionals and Glue Dots)
- Paper Trimmer with cutting and scoring blade
- Bone folder
- Scissors
- Images for greetings
- Ink
- 4" x 5-1/4" pieces of Basic White CS or printer paper (9 pieces)



Before Getting Started: Cut off ¾" from each of the 4x6 pieces of DSP so that the pieces measure 4" x 5-1/4".

Card Project #1 – Overlapping Offset Gatefold Card








Score 1-1/4" from one side and 3-1/4" from the other side of the card base to create the fun fold.

Tip: Pop up the focal image with dimensionals to make it easier to tuck the smaller gate underneath.

Card Project #2 - Easy Tag Layout







Tips: Think in thirds with this layout. Place the strip about 1" or 1/3 of the way across the front. Place the tag over the strip about 1/3 of the way from the other side. Tie 4"-5" of ribbon through the hold in the tag or just tie a knot with 3" of ribbon and attach with a glue dot. using three small sequins inside the larger flower fills the flower center.

Card Project #3 - Diagonal Flip Card







Tips: Line up the diagonal corners on the cutting line then, starting in the middle of the DSP, cut out to each corner. Carefully turn the paper holding the pieces together and cut diagonally from the other 2 corners to make 4 triangles. Glue the triangles onto copy paper flipping 2 opposite triangles to the other pattern.






Card Project #4 - Center Pop-Out Standing Fun Fold



Score in 2" and 3-1/8" from each side of the card base to make the fun fold.

Tips: Add a 2" x 5-1/4" piece of Basic White or copy paper to the back side of the center pop-out as a place to write the personal message.







<u>Card Project #5 – Left Centered Layers</u>



Tips: All three layers attach along the fold and centered. To attach the vellum, use adhesive under the spot where the greeting piece will attach.





Card Project #6 – Lovely Layers



Tips: 2" x 5-1/4" piece is centered down the front of the card. The 3" square is centered over this in the top third of the card front. Attach the $\frac{1}{2}$ " strip to the stamped focal point then pop up the entire cluster 1/3 of the way up from the bottom of the square on either side.





Card Project #7 – Layered Triangles







Tips: Cut the DSP diagonally by lining up the two opposite corners along the cutting groove. Remember to start your cutting blade in the middle of the paper and move out to the corners. Attach the focal point die cut to the ½" strip first then pop up the entire cluster onto the card front. Fold the ribbon into a V and attach near flower like leaves.



Bonus Card Fronts

Use the larger leftover pieces to cover a piece of copy paper for an easy card front.





Use the leftover strips to do some faux quilting. Attach to a piece of copy paper, trim edges & use and embossing folder!
