Inspiration Sheet - Cascading Trifold Card

A fun fold card with a lovely silhouette!

Supplies (to make 2 cards at one time)

- 11" x 8-1/2" cardstock (makes 2 cards)
- 5-1/4" x 4" DSP (2) for large panel
- 4-1/4" x 3-1/2" DSP (2) for medium panel
- 3-1/2" x 2-3/4" DSP (2) for small panel
- 4-1/4" x 3-1/2" Basic White (2) for medium panel
- Scraps/pieces for focal point cluster
- Ribbon and/or embellishments

Directions

- 1. With the cardstock oriented with the 8-1/2" edge at the top and bottom, make a pencil mark 3" from the top right corner and the bottom left corner of the 11" x 8-1/2" piece of cardstock.
- 2. Cut between the two marks, cutting the cardstock in half at an angle.
- 3. Score along the 11" straight edge of each piece measuring from the 5-1/2" edge at 4-1/4" and 8".
- 4. Fold on the score lines like a "Z" with the 5-1/2" edge in the back on the right, and the smallest panel in front (with the 3-1/2" edge on the left).
- 5. The large, medium and small pieces of DSP will be attached to the panels of the card base that face the front. To make the DSP top edges match the angles of the cardbase, first line up the DSP so that you have 1/8" border around the bottom and side edges, then slide the DSP up another 1/8" from the bottom, hold and trim the top along the angled edge. Do this for the large, medium, and small DSP pieces and the Basic White piece for the middle on the inside.
- 6. Create a focal point cluster and adhere to the front, small panel.
- 7. Embellish as desired.
