## Stampin' Inspiration - Template \#16

## Supplies

- $51 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ x $81 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ card base
- $4^{\prime \prime}$ x $5-1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ cardstock
- $4-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ x 3 DSP \#1
- 2" x 4" DSP \#2
- 2-1/4" square DSP \#3
- Basic White circle punch of die (2-1/4" - 2-1/2")
- Ribbon or embellishments

Optional

- $4-3 / 4$ " x $3-1 / 4$ " coordinating cardstock


Placement for ribbon or accent piece
DSP \#1: Choose a piece that has multiple colors and the most bold pattern.
DSP \#2: Choose a pattern that contrasts with DSP \#1. Stripes are fun.
DSP \#3: Choose a softer coordinating pattern.

## Directions

1. Adhere the $4 " \times 5-1 / 4 "$ piece of cardstock on the card base. Options: stamp a background on this piece or use an embossing folder.
2. Attach the $4-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 3$ " DSP \#1 piece centered on the card front with equal space top \& bottom ( $1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ ) , and left \& right (3/8"). Optional: Mount this piece on 4-3/4" x 3-1/4" coordinating cardstock.
3. Adhere the 2 " x 4 " DSP \#2 piece perpendicular to DSP \#1 on the right edge leaving $1 / 4$ " showing.
4. Attach the $2-1 / 4$ " square DSP \# 3 piece overlapping piece \#2 and centered inside DSP $\# 1$ with the right edge layered under the focal point piece.
5. Pop up and attach the focal point shape over DSP \#2 \& \#3.
6. Embellish as desired.
