## Stampin' Inspiration - 3 Layered Rectangles Template \#15



## Supplies

- $51 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ x $81 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ card base
- 4" x 5-1/4" cardstock
- 2" x 4-3/4" DSP \#1
- 2" x 3-1/2" DSP \# 2

DSP \#1: Choose a piece that has multiple colors and the most bold pattern.
DSP \#2: Choose a pattern that contrasts with DSP \#1.
DSP \#3: Choose a coordinating pattern. Stripes are fun.

## Directions

1. Adhere the $4 " \times 5-1 / 4 "$ piece of cardstock on the card base. Options: stamp a background on this piece or use an embossing folder.
2. Attach the $2^{\prime \prime} \times 4-3 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ DSP \#1 piece along the left edge of the card front about $1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ from the top, bottom and left edge of the $4 \prime$ " $\times 5-1 / 4 \prime$ " piece of cardstock.
3. Adhere the $1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 2-3 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ DSP \#3 piece along and under the right edge of DSP \#2 so that only $1 / 4$ " shows.
4. Attach the $2^{\prime \prime} \times 3-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ DSP \# 2 piece overlapping piece \#1 by 1 " and centered top and bottom.
5. Pop up and attach the focal point shape over the the section where DSP \#1 \& \#2 overlap.
6. Embellish as desired.
