## Stampin' Inspiration - 4 Lovely Layers Template \#19



## Supplies

- $51 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ x $81 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ card base
- 4 " x $5-1 / 4$ " cardstock
- $1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ x 4 " DSP \#1
- 2" x 4-3/4" DSP \#2
- 2" x 3-3/4" DSP \# 3
- 2-1/2" x 2-1/2" DSP \#4
- Focal Point Basic White any size or shape
- Ribbon or embellishments

DSP \#1: Choose a piece with a tone on tone design and subtle pattern.
DSP \#2: Choose a pattern that has several colors. Stripes are fun.
DSP \#3: This piece should be the one with all the colors and the busiest pattern.
DSP \#4: Choose a coordinating subtle pattern.

## Directions

1. Optional: Stamp a background image on the $4 " \times 5-1 / 4 "$ piece of cardstock or use an embossing folder. Attach to card base.
2. Attach the $1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ x 4 " DSP \#1 piece horizontally across the $4 " \times 5-1 / 4$ " piece of cardstock and centered in the middle top and bottom.
3. Adhere the 2 " x $4-3 / 4$ " DSP \#2 piece along the right edge of the card front leaving a $1 / 4$ " margin to the edge of the 4 " $\times 5-1 / 4$ " piece of cardstock.
4. Attach the 2 " x $3-3 / 4$ " DSP \# 3 piece overlapping piece \#2 by 1 " and centered top and bottom. The distance between the left edge of piece \#3 and the right edge of piece \#2 should measure 3 ".
5. Attach the $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ DSP \#4 piece centered between the left and right edges of pieces \#1 \& \#2 and centered over piece \#1. It will be slightly right of the true center of the card front.
6. Create a focal point to attach to piece \#4 and embellish as desired.
