## Supplies

- $51 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ x $81 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ card base
- $1-1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ x $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ DSP \#1
- $1-1 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ DSP \#2
- $1-1 / 4$ " x $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ DSP \# 3
- 1-1/4" x 2-1/2" DSP \#4
- 2-1/2" x 3-1/2" Basic White*
- $2-3 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 3-3 / 4$ " cardstock matte


## Options

- $1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 5-1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ cardstock
- 4" x 5-1/4" cardstock
*the focal point piece can be ANY size or shape to fit the stamp image or greeting you are using.


## Designer Series Paper Choices

- Choose four different and coordinating patterns.
- Choose one scenic piece and cut into four pieces (start with a piece measuring 5 " x 2-1/2")
- Choose the same pattern for all four pieces.
- Choose three coordinating pieces and one Basic White Piece for stamping the greeting.


## Directions

1. Attach DSP \#1 first $1 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ from the top and side edge. Next, attach DSP \#4 (1/8" from the bottom and side edge.) Then attach DSP \#2 \& DSP \#3 leaving $1 / 8$ " in between all the rectangles.
2. Optional Step - stamp or emboss the $1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 5-1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ cardstock and attach $1 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ from the fold.
3. Stamp and created a focal point on the $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 3-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ piece of Basic White, then mount onto the $2-3 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 3-3 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ piece of coordinating cardstock to matte the focal point.
4. Add embellishments.
