
Stampin' Inspiration - Stacked Rectangles Template #20





Supplies

- 5 1/2" x 8 1/2" card base
- 1-1/4" x 2-1/2" DSP #1
- 1-1/4" x 2-1/2" DSP #2
- 1-1/4" x 2-1/2" DSP # 3
- 1-1/4" x 2-1/2" DSP #4
- 2-1/2" x 3-1/2" Basic White*
- 2-3/4" x 3-3/4" cardstock matte

Options

- 1-1/2" x 5-1/4" cardstock
- 4" x 5-1/4" cardstock

*the focal point piece can be ANY size or shape to fit the stamp image or greeting you are using.

Designer Series Paper Choices

- Choose four different and coordinating patterns.
- Choose one scenic piece and cut into four pieces (start with a piece measuring 5" x 2-1/2")
- Choose the same pattern for all four pieces.
- Choose three coordinating pieces and one Basic White Piece for stamping the greeting.

Directions

- 1. Attach DSP #1 first 1/8" from the top and side edge. Next, attach DSP #4 (1/8" from the bottom and side edge.) Then attach DSP #2 & DSP #3 leaving 1/8" in between all the rectangles.
- 2. Optional Step stamp or emboss the 1-1/2" x 5-1/4" cardstock and attach 1/8" from the fold.
- 3. Stamp and created a focal point on the 2-1/2" x 3-1/2" piece of Basic White, then mount onto the 2-3/4" x 3-3/4" piece of coordinating cardstock to matte the focal point.
- 4. Add embellishments.
