## Stampin' Inspiration - Uneven Four-Square Template \#21



## Supplies

- $51 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ x $81 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ card base
- 2" x 2" DSP \#1
- $2^{\prime \prime}$ x 3-1/4" DSP \#2
- 2" x 2" DSP \# 3
- 2" x 3-1/4" DSP \#4
- 2" Circle Basic White*
- 2-3/8" Circle Coordinating Cardstock
*the focal point piece can be ANY size or shape to fit the stamp image or greeting you are using.


## Designer Series Paper Choices

- Choose four different and coordinating patterns.
- Choose one scenic piece and cut into four pieces (start with a piece measuring 5-1/4" x 4")
- Choose the same pattern for all four pieces.
- Use a neutral cardstock color measuring $5-1 / 4^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{x} 4$ ", and stamp a background/collage then cut apart into the pieces.


## Directions

1. Attach DSP \#1 first $1 / 8 "$ from the top left corner. Next, attach DSP \#4 ( $1 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ from the bottom left corner.) Then attach DSP \#2 \& DSP \#3 leaving $1 / 8$ " in between all the pieces.
2. Stamp and created a focal point on the 2" Circle on Basic White, then mount onto the $2-3 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ circle punch out of coordinating cardstock to matte the focal point.
3. Attach the focal point anywhere on the card front where there is an intersection formed by the $1 / 8$ " gaps between the DSP pieces.
4. Add embellishments.
