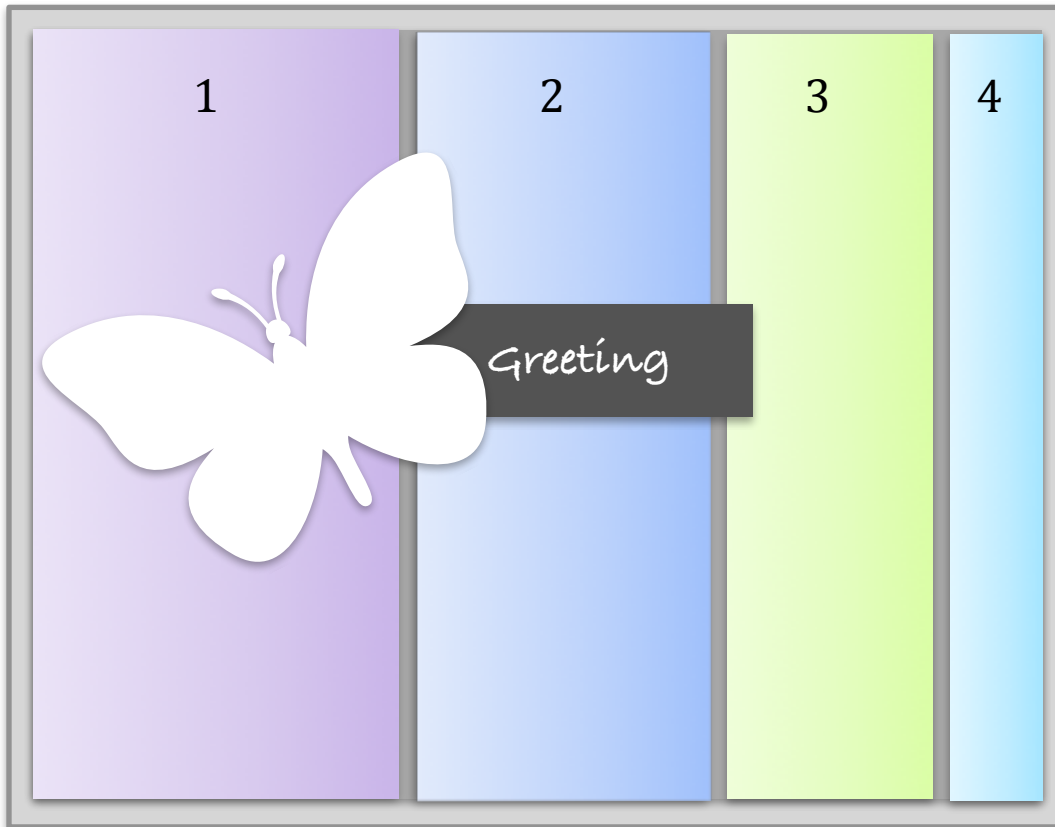




Stampin' Inspiration - Graduated Strips Template #23



Supplies - Makes 2 Cards at One Time

- 8-1/2" x 11" cardstock cut into two card bases measuring 8-1/2" x 5-1/2"
- 5-1/4" x 4" cardstock matching card base (cut 2)
- 4" x 5" DSP (2 different double-sided DSP)
- Focal point piece/accent - the focal point can be ANY size or shape to layer over a few of the DSP strips.
- Die-cut/punched shape for greeting - the die-cut/punched shape can also be any shape to accommodate the greeting.
- 3 embellishments

Choices and Options

- Choose one scenic pattern piece and cut into four strips.
- Use the same pattern for all four strips.
- Use a neutral cardstock color measuring 5" x 4", and stamp a background, collage, or use an embossing folder. Then cut apart into the strips.

Directions

1. Cutting along the 5" sides of the 4" x 5" pieces of DSP, cut at 2", 1-1/2", and 1". These three cuts will give you the 4 graduated strip sizes you need.
2. Attach the pieces of DSP on the 4-1/4" x 5-1/4" pieces of cardstock so that there is approximately 1/8" in between the strips. Attach the 2" and 1/2" pieces first meeting the edges of the cardstock, then attach the 1-1/2" and 1" strips leaving 1/8" in between. Attach this piece to the center of the card front.
3. Attach the focal point/accent that will overlap at least 2 of the DSP strips anywhere on the card front.
4. Add embellishments.
