Stampin' Inspiration - Cornered Rectangles Template #25





Supplies

- 5 1/2" x 8-1/2" card base
- 4" x 5-1/4" coordinating or neutral cardstock
- 2-3/4" x 4" DSP #1
- 2-3/4" x 1" DSP #2
- 1" x 2" DSP #3
- 1" x 3" DSP #4
- Die / Punched shape for greeting and/or focal point.

For Scenery DSP or Stack, Cut, & Shuffle Technique

• Start with a piece(s) 3-3/4" x 5" and cut into corresponding sizes

To Attach Pieces Directly to Card Base

(Leave out the $4'' \times 5-1/4''$ layer)

- 2-3/4" x 4" DSP #1
- 2-3/4" x 1-1/4" DSP #2
- 1-1/4" x 2" DSP #3
- 1-1/4" x 3" DSP #4

Choices and Options

- Choose four different and coordinating patterns from the same package of DSP.
- Switch out any of the four sections with stamped images, or embossed coordinating color of cardstock to add texture.
- Choose a scenery paper and cut into the sized pieces for a great effect!
- \bullet Choose four coordinating pieces (all cut to 3-3/4" x 5") and do the Stack, Cut, & Shuffle technique.

Directions

- 1. Arrange and attach the four pieces of DSP to the $4" \times 5-1/4"$ neutral cardstock leaving approximately 1/16" in between and around the edges. (Just make the spaces look even).
- 2. Attach this layer to the center of the card front.
- 3. Add a focal point shape of ANY kind and center it (mostly in the largest section) of DSP#1.
- 4. Add embellishments.
