Pop Out Gatefold Portrait Version


- 5-1/2" x 8-1/2" cardstock for card base
- 5-1/4" x 1-7/8" DSP (4)
- 5-1/4" x 1-5/8" DSP (2)
- 5-1/4" x 3/8 DSP (optional for center spine)
- 4" x 4" Basic White cardstock
- 5-1/4" x 1-5/8" Basic White cardstock (2)
- Two focal point shapes to make tuck closure on gatefolds
- Pop Out feature no larger than 4" x 5-1/4"

Directions

- 1. Score at 2-1/8", and 4" in from both sides along the 8-1/2" edge.
- 2. Fold on the 2-1/8" score lines toward the inside of the card to create the gates.
- 3. Fold on the 4" score lines toward the back of the card to create a center spine in the middle of the inside.
- 4. Attach the DSP/cardstock pieces to front and inside sections.
- 5. Attach the inside pop out feature along the ½" spine.
- 6. Attach and overlap the two focal point shapes into a tuck closure to keep the gatefolds closed.



Pop Out Gatefold Landscape Version

- 4-1/4" x 11" cardstock for card base
- 4" x 2" DSP (2) (optional 2 more for back side)
- 4" x 2-1/2" DSP (4) (2 for outside, 2 for inside)
- 4" x 3/4" for spine
- 4" x 4" Basic White cardstock
- Two focal point shapes to make tuck closure on gatefolds
- Pop Out feature no larger than 4" x 5-1/4"

Directions

- 1. Score at 2-3/4", and 5" in from both sides along the 11" edge.
- 2. Fold on the 2-3/4" score lines toward the inside of the card to create the gates.
- 3. Fold on the 5" score lines toward the back of the card to create a center spine in the middle of the inside.
- 4. Attach the DSP/cardstock pieces to front and inside sections.
- 5. Attach the inside pop out feature along the 1" spine.
- 6. Attach and overlap the two focal point shapes into a tuck closure to keep the gatefolds closed.







Inspiration Sheet – Pop Out Gatefold Cards

Three ways to make a basic gatefold card "pop"! (Papercrafting Playdate 152)

Pop Out Gatefold Portrait Split Version

- 5-1/2" x 8" cardstock for card base
- 5-3/8" x 1-7/8" DSP or cardstock (4) (2 for outside, 2 for inside)
- 1-1/8" x 1-7/8" DSP (4)
- 7/8" x 2-7/8" DSP (2)
- 2-7/8" x 1-7/8" (2) for center and back
- Two focal point shapes to make tuck closure on gatefolds

Directions

- 1. Score at 2" from both sides along the 8" edge.
- 2. Turn and cut a 1-1/4" slit from the top and bottom edges between the two 2" score lines.
- 3. Turn back and score at 4" on the top and bottom sections.
- 4. Score the middle section at 3" from each side.
- 5. Attach the DSP pieces to the sections on the inside and outside of card.
- 6. Create an inside focal point on the 2-7/8" x 1-7/8" piece.
- 7. Attach and overlap the two focal point shapes into a tuck closure to keep the gatefolds closed.
