
Stampin' Inspiration - Secretly Centered Template #31





Supplies

- 5-1/2" x 8-1/2" card base
- 1-1/2" x 5-1/2" DSP #1
- 2" x 3-1/2" DSP #2
- 1" x 3" DSP #3
- 2" x 4" DSP #4 or cardstock
- Die cut or punched shape for greeting or focal point.

Choose DSP patterns that coordinate and contrast with each other. One of the pieces should have multiple colors that ties the other pieces together.

Directions

- 1. Stamp a gentle background image at least three times directly on the front of the cardbase and going off the edges. Shoot for the empty spaces and stamp in a triangle spacing (approximately where the Xs are).
- 2. Attach the 1-1/2" \times 5-1/2" DSP #1 piece along the bottom edge of the card front about 5/8" from the edge.
- 3. With scissors, make a banner end on the right side of the 2" x 4" DSP (or cardstock) #4 piece. Attach this piece overlapping DSP #1 by 3/4" and centering it between the right and left sides of the card front.
- 4. Attach the 2" x 3-1/2" DSP #2 piece overlapping DSPs #1 & #4. Center this piece between the top and bottom edges (approx. 3/8" from top and bottom) of the card front, and leaving 1/4" of DSP #4 showing on the left side.
- 5. Attach the 1" x 3" DSP #4 piece overlapping all of the other DSP pieces, and specifically overlapping DSPs #1 & #4 by 1/2" each.
- 6. Pop up a die cut or punched shape with your greeting and/or focal point image. The perfect spot for this piece is at the intersection of DSPs #2, #3, & #4

Options

• Use piece #2 to stamp a larger focal image. Add a popped-up embellishment image instead of the greeting die cut/punch and ribbon instead of DSP #3.
