



Inspiration Sheet - Easy Easel Cards

A simple fun fold that pops up for display! (Papercrafting Playdate 173)


Measurements - Basic Landscape (horizontal) & Portrait (vertical) Versions

Portrait

- 4-1/4" x 11" card base scored at 2-3/4" and 5-1/2"
- 4" x 5-1/4" card front
- 4" x 5-1/4" Basic White for inside
- 2" x 4" DSP for inside
- 4" x 2-5/8" (2) DSP OPTIONAL if covering card front

Landscape

- 5-1/2" x 8-1/2" card base scored at 2-1/8" and 4-1/4"
- 4" x 5-1/4" card front
- 4" x 5-1/4" Basic White for inside
- 2" x 5-1/4" DSP for inside
- 5-1/4" x 2" (2) OPTIONAL if covering card front



Directions

1. Score card bases in half then score the front of the card in half also. Fold on score lines in the same direction and crease well. Attach the decorated 4" x 5-1/4" card front to the lower part of the card base only. Assemble the inside cardstock with DSP along the lower edge. Pop up a die cut, or punched shape on the inside near the DSP edge to act as a "stopper" to hold up the easel for display.



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
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Measurements - Center Easel Version

- 5-1/2" x 8-1/2" card base, scored at 4-1/4"
- 4" x 2-3/4" - cardstock for center panel or a die cut shape
- 4" x 2-3/4" - Basic White cardstock for inside
- 2-3/4" x 1-1/2" DSP for inside
- 1" x 4" patterned paper (2)
- 2-3/4" x 2" (2) optional

Directions

1. Fold the card base on the score line. Determine the front of the card base. Using the paper trimmer, cut 1-1/4" from each edge of the card base front from the bottom up to the score line. These two cuts will make 3 panels on the card front. The center panel will measure 3" across.
2. Measure and score at the halfway point (2-1/8") of the center panel and fold in half. This center panel should fold towards the inside of the card base.
3. Adhere both of the 1-1/4" side panels to the inside of the card base leaving only the center panel moveable.
4. Adhere the 1" x 4" strips of patterned paper over these panels.
5. Stamp/emboss/embellish the 4" x 2-3/4" piece of cardstock as desired. Mount this piece onto the lower half of the center panel. This will be the piece that stands up. Or add the optional DSP pieces to the top and bottom and mount a die cut to the center panel.
6. Adhere the other Basic White cardstock to the inside of the card base along with the DSP at the bottom edge.
7. Attach a punched/die cut shape popped-up with dimensionals approximately 1-1/2" from the bottom edge. This creates the "stop" to tuck the folded center panel behind to display the card.



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Measurements - Side Easel Version

- 5-1/2" x 8-1/2" card base, scored at 4-1/4"
- 4" x 4" - cardstock for center panel or a die cut shape
- 4" x 4" - Basic White cardstock for inside
- 4" x 1-1/2" DSP for inside
- 1" x 4" patterned paper (1)
- 4" x 2" (2) optional

Directions

1. Fold the card base on the score line. Determine the front of the card base. Using the paper trimmer, cut 1-1/4" from either the right or left edge of the card base front from the bottom up to the score line.
2. Measure and score at the halfway point (2-1/8") of the side panel and fold in half.
3. Adhere the 1-1/4" side panels to the inside of the card base.
4. Adhere the 1" x 4" strips of patterned paper.
5. Stamp/emboss/embellish the 4" x 4" piece of cardstock as desired. Mount this piece onto the lower half of the side panel. This will be the piece that stands up. Or add the optional DSP pieces to the top and bottom and mount a die cut to the center panel.
6. Adhere the other Basic White cardstock to the inside of the card base along with the DSP at the bottom edge.
7. Attach a punched/die cut shape popped-up with dimensionals approximately 1-1/2" from the bottom edge. This creates the "stop" to tuck the folded center panel behind to display the card.
