



Inspiration Sheet - Really Great Gatefold Cards

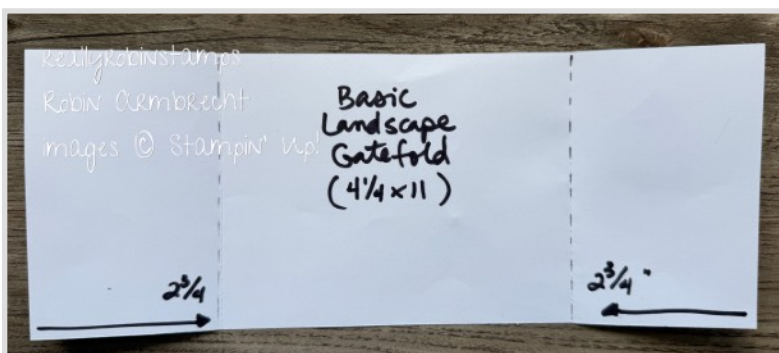
Ways to make landscape gatefold cards with slight variations. (Papercrafting Playdate 178)

Basic Landscape Gatefold

- 4-1/4" x 11" card base
- 2-1/2" x 4" (2) DSP
- Focal point any size or shape.
- 4" x 5 1/4" Basic White cardstock for inside

Directions

1. Score card base along long edge at 2-3/4" from each edge. Fold on one score line and crease well. Fold the other side in to meet in the center and press on the other 2-3/4" score line. Attach DSP to the doors.
2. Create a focal point. Attach one half of this piece to one of the gatefold doors

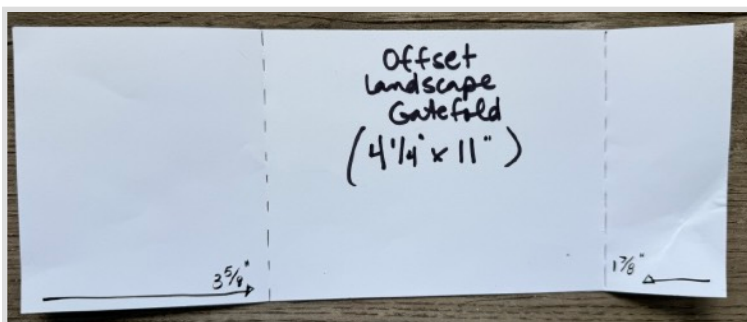


Offset Landscape Gatefold

- 4-1/4" x 11" card base
- 4" x 1-5/8" (3) DSP (or 3-3/8" x 4 (1 piece), and 1-5/8" x 4" (1 piece)).
- Focal point and small die cut/punch as an embellishment.
- 4" x 5-1/4" Basic White cardstock for inside (or 8" x 5-1/4" scored at 4")

Directions

1. Score card base along long edge at 1-7/8" from one edge and 3-5/8" from the other. Fold on one score line and crease well. Fold the other side in to meet in the center and crease well.
2. Attach DSP to the doors. One side gets one piece of DSP and the other gets two pieces.
3. Attach the 4" x 5 1/4" Basic White on the inside of the card and stamp inside greeting.
4. Create a focal point. Attach half of the focal point to one door. Pop up a smaller embellishment on the other door for the focal point to tuck under and create a latch.

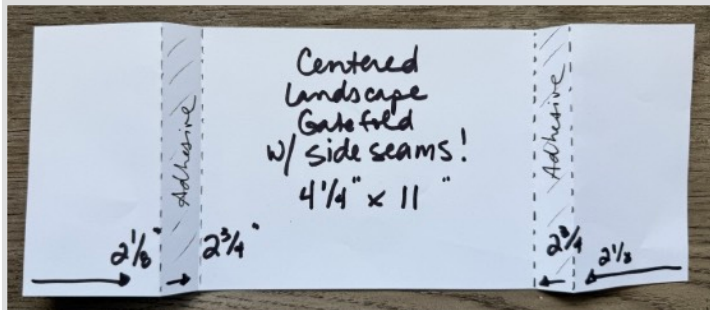
Ways to make landscape gatefold cards with slight variations. (Papercrafting Playdate 178)

Centered Landscape Gatefold with Side Seams

- 4-1/4" x 11" card base
- 4" x 1-7/8" (2 or 4) DSP #1
- 4" x 3/8" (2) DSP #2
- Focal point and small die cut/punch as an embellishment.
- 4" x 4" Basic White cardstock for inside (or 8" x 4" scored at 4")

Directions

1. Score card base along long edge at 2-1/8" and 2-3/4" from each side. Fold on the 2-3/4" score lines first and create the center gatefold, then fold on the 2-1/8" score lines in the opposite direction and crease well.
2. Adhere the space between the 2-1/8" and 2-3/4" score lines to the inside of the card.
3. Attach DSP #1 to the doors, inside and outside.
4. Attach DSP #2 to the side seams.
5. Attach the 4" x 4" Basic White on the inside of the card and stamp inside greeting (or make an inside card measuring 4" x 8").
6. Create a focal point. Attach half of the focal point to one door. Pop up a smaller embellishment on the other door for the focal point to tuck under and create a latch.

Ways to make landscape gatefold cards with slight variations. (Papercrafting Playdate 178)

Centered Landscape Gatefold Short Doors that Lock

- 4-1/4" x 9-1/2" cardstock
- 1-1/8" x 4" DSP #1(4)
- 4" x 8" cardstock or DSP #2
- Focal point shape approximately 2-3/4" - 3" wide

Directions

1. Score the 4-1/4" x 9-1/2" card base at 1-3/8" and 2" in from each edge.
2. Fold the 2" score lines towards then inside of the card and fold the 1-3/8" score lines in the opposite direction.
3. Use adhesive in the 5/8" section between the score lines and attach to the inside of the card.
4. Attach the 1-1/8" x 4" pieces of DSP on the front and backs of the gatefolds.
5. Fold the 4" x 8" piece in half and attach to the inside of the card.
6. Center and attach the focal point to the front of the inside card (in between the gatefolds) with dimensionals. Make sure the dimensionals are only in the center of the focal point so that the edges of the gatefolds can tuck underneath to lock the card closed.
