



Inspiration Sheet - Uneven Four Square Cards

Card Cousins with similar features in common. (Papercrafting Playdate 184 on July 24th, 2026)

Uneven Four Square Card

- 5-1/2" x 8-1/2" card base
- 2" x 2" DSP #1
- 2" x 3-1/4" DSP #2
- 2" x 2" DSP #3
- 2" x 3-1/4" DSP #4
- Punched/Die cut greeting shape



Directions

1. Evenly space the DSP pieces around the edges of the card front leaving equal space in between approximately 1/16".
2. The punched/die cut greeting piece represented by the white circle can be any shape or size and be placed anywhere on focal point.

Split Uneven Four Square Card

- 5-1/2" x 8-1/2" card base
- 1" x 2" DSP #1(2)
- 1" x 2" DSP #2 (2)
- 1" x 3-1/4" DSP #1 (2)
- 1" x 3-1/4" DSP #2 (2)
- Punched/Die cut greeting shape

Directions

1. Arrange and attach the two different DSP patterns into squares and rectangles around the edges of the card front. Use DSP #2 around the insides of the squares and rectangles and DSP #1 around the outside edges to create a fun pattern.



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Puzzle Slider Fun Fold

- 4-1/4" x 9-1/2" card base
- 4" x 5-1/4" Basic White for inside
- 2-1/8" x 3-3/8" cardstock (2) (same as card base)
- 2-1/8" x 2-1/8" cardstock (2) (same as card base)
- 2" x 2" DSP #1
- 2" x 3-1/4" DSP #2
- 2" x 2" DSP #3
- 2" x 3-1/4" DSP #4
- Punched/Die cut greeting

Directions

1. Score the card base at 1" and 2" from each side measuring along the long edge.
2. Fold the 2" score lines towards the inside of the card and fold the 1" scores lines back in the opposite direction to create the "slider" mechanism of the card front.
3. With the slider edges closed, arrange and attach the card front puzzle pieces (2-1/8" x 2-1/8" and 2-1/8" x 3-3/8" - four pieces) to the slider section on top aligning the pieces with the edge. Attach them so that the squares are in opposite corners.
4. Add the Basic White to the inside and attach a greeting on the front over one of the sections.
