



Inspiration Sheet - Focus on the Middle

Card Cousins with similar features in common. (Papercrafting Playdate 190 on Sept. 24th, 2026)

Really Simple Layout #4

- 5-1/2" x 8-1/2" card base
- 1-1/8" x 4" DSP #1 (2)
- 2-3/4" x 4" DSP #2
- Punched/Die cut greeting shape

Directions

1. Evenly space the DSP pieces around the edges of the card front leaving equal space in between approximately 1/8".
2. The punched/die cut greeting piece represented by the white circle can be any shape or size and be placed anywhere on focal point.

Note: If using a piece of scenery paper, start with a piece 4" x 5"



Stepped-Up RSL #4

- 5-1/2" x 8-1/2" card base
- 1-1/8" x 4" DSP #1 (2)
- 2-1/2" x 4" DSP #2
- 1-1/4" x 4-1/8" cardstock (2)
- 2-5/8" x 4-1/8" cardstock
- Punched/Die cut greeting shape

Note: If using a piece of scenery paper, start with a piece 4" x 4-3/4"



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Mini Center Z-Fold

- 4-1/4" x 5-1/2" (2)
- 4-1/8" x 1-1/4" coordinating cardstock (2)
- 4-1/8" x 2-5/8" coordinating cardstock (1)
- 2-1/2" x 4" DSP #2
- 1-1/8" x 4" DSP #1(2)
- 2-1/2" x 4" Basic White
- Punched/Die cut greeting

Directions

1. Score one of the 4-1/4" x 5-1/2" pieces at 2-3/4" and 4-1/8" along the long edge. Fold in half on the 2-3/4" score line and in the opposite direction on the 4-1/8" score line.
2. After attaching the layered pieces on the outside edges of the card base, center and attach the mini z-fold in between them.
3. Attach the layered center panel to the section folded back leaving a 1/16" border.
4. Add the Basic White to the inside and attach a greeting/focal point on the front.
